On Wednesday, June 10, 2008, three Central Trunk Project team members met with the staff of the Acacia Meadows Apartments to address their questions and inform them about the start of construction in their area. The Acacia Meadows Apartments residents will be sharing their driveway with the vehicles that will frequent the project staging area on the corner of Stockton Boulevard and Elsie Avenue. Amber Parmer, Project Engineer began the meeting by introducing the team, and establishing that a portion of the field to the South of the apartment complex would be utilized as a staging area for the project. She then shared samples of the deteriorated sewer pipe, the pipe as it should be, and materials from the CIPP liner that will go into the sewer pipeline to reinforce it. The meeting quickly turned to questions posed by the Acacia Meadows Staff. The Sacramento Area Sewer District, and HDR|The Hoyt Company staff answered the questions thoroughly and assured the stakeholders that they would be informed as soon as the schedule for construction was solidified. The staff at Acacia Meadows stated that they would like to be notified of who the security company will be onsite at the staging area. Dillon Miele noticed that the apartment complex had a leak in the field adjacent to one of the parking areas, and promptly informed Acacia Meadows staff. He then checked with his supervisor and identified the name of the water company responsible for the leak. The Acacia Meadows team were quite grateful for his help.

During the question and answer session, HDR|The Hoyt Company recorded all comments and questions. See below:

- How long will you be in the area?

- Will utilities on our side be affected?
- Will the bypass pumping go away?
- When will you be in this area?
- Will it be a dusty mess because of the dirt in the field?
- What are the hours of noise impacts going to be?
- Do we have a choice in this matter?
- What will be the entry/exit points for the staging area?
- What security company will you be using?
- Will there be a ramp or curbing for the entrance to the staging area?
- The estimated time of completion will be March of 2010?
- When will the staging area begin to set up?
- Will there be a wet-down process for the dirt in the field?
