- Has SASD done this kind of work before?
- What is the budget for this project?
- What is the duration of the project?
- Do you have to go back in and cut laterals along this pipeline?
- Is this more cost effective over replacing the entire pipeline?
- Can we get the map PDF sent to us?
- What is the purpose of the tent?
- Is there an air quality issue?
- Will the tent be right in the middle of the road?
- How does the crown spraying wash off in the winter?
