Septic-to-Sewer
Conversion Project
Moving Forward!**

Dear Linda Manor community,

I am excited to share some more good news concerning the Linda Manor Septic-to-Sewer Conversion Project. This unique opportunity to bring public sewer service to the Linda Manor community is about to become a reality—at no cost to participating homeowners. A funding agreement with the State of California is in the works, and the Sacramento Area Sewer District (SASD) is moving ahead with design of the project.

The next steps are outlined in the attached letter from SASD. As planners and engineers prepare to design the new sewer system, all property owners are being asked to please state their interest in connecting to sewer service. If enough properties want to connect, the project will move forward. While connecting to sewer is strictly voluntary, please keep in mind that 100% funding like this is not likely to be available in the future. With many existing septic systems no longer meeting current regulatory requirements, owners of these systems will likely be required to connect to sewer (at their own expense) as their septic systems age and break down.

I would like to thank everyone who has been involved in this process to date. There is still much work to be done before construction can begin, but we can all feel optimistic that reliable sewer service for Linda Manor residents is on its way. I will be working with SASD to host a community meeting this summer, when we can meet with all of you and discuss the project in more detail. Thanks for your patience!
