



Minimum Geotechnical Report Requirements

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This document outlines the minimum requirements for geotechnical reports. The Sacramento Area Sewer District (SASD) requires the following in geotechnical reports:

- Reviews, studies, investigations, tests, analyses, and reports necessary to adequately describe the geotechnical conditions for the project
- Geotechnical information necessary for the design of the project
- Geotechnical conditions that present risks to the project costs and project timeline
- Recommended mitigation measures for these risks

A geotechnical report is required at SASD's discretion and for SASD reimbursable and pump station projects.

Geotechnical reports expire after five years from when the report was prepared. Reports over five years old require a memo from the engineer of record stating the report is still valid or a summary of changes within the report.
